'It's their age ...'

A Thomas Robert Daley was born on the 21st May 1994. He is an English diver who specialises in the 10 metre platform event and is currently the FINA World Champion. He started diving at the age of seven and has made an impact in national and international competition at an early age. He represented Great Britain at the 2008 Summer Olympics, where he was Britain's youngest competitor, the youngest competitor of any nationality outside the sport of swimming, and the youngest to participate in a final. He lives in England with father Robert, mother Debbie and two brothers, William and Ben. He won two gold medals at the 2010 Commonwealth Games, in the 10 metre synchro diving event (with Max Brick) and the 10 metre individual platform competition.



- B Kishan is only ten. Starting at the age of four, he has already acted in twenty-four feature films and has starred in 1,000 episodes of a hit soap opera on television in India. Now he's directing a full-length feature film about a child who lives on the streets. 'When I was six years old, I saw children selling newspapers at the traffic lights and my dad said they do not have parents. I thought I must do something for them,' Kishan told the BBC. Now he juggles school and filming, and although he misses out on playing with his friends, he has no regrets. He has his critics, however, who believe that he is having to become an adult too quickly, which is ironic, considering the subject matter of his film.
- C Leona Louise Lewis was born on the 3rd April 1985. She is a British pop singer and songwriter. She auditioned for The X Factor in 2006 and after being announced the winner, received a £1 million recording contract. Leona has released two albums to date, Spirit and Echo, in 2007 and 2009 respectively. Spirit became the fastest-selling debut album and the biggest seller of 2007 in both the United Kingdom and Ireland. It has sold over 6.5 million copies worldwide. Leona's debut single 'A Moment Like This' became the fastest selling UK single after being downloaded over 50,000 times within 30 minutes of its release. Her second single, 'Bleeding Love', reached number one positions in over thirty singles charts around the world.
- Rabbit Kekai is a top international surfer. He comes from Hawaii and started surfing at the age of four. There are many top surfers from Hawaii, and many of them start young. Not many of them, however, continue surfing and competing in tournaments around the world as long as Rabbit, who is now an incredible eighty-three years old. He and his wife Lynn live in an apartment which is just 200 metres from Waikiki beach, and he gets up at 5.00 a.m. every single day of the year and goes straight down to the beach. He earns his living by teaching surfing and making commercials, but says, 'I still prefer to compete. I had six or seven first places last year. To be honest, I surf to keep alive.'
